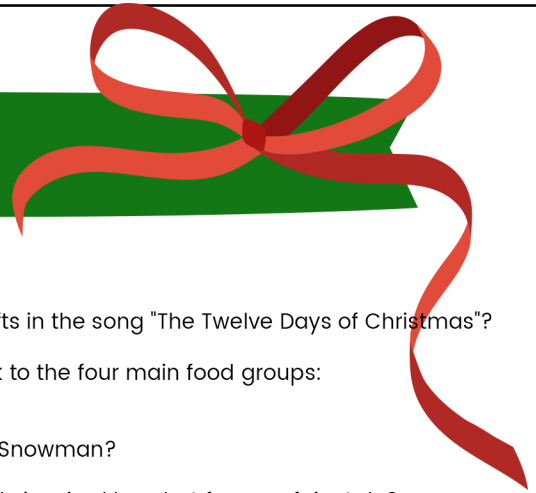


Christmas TRIVIA GAME
